






## Seasonal Precipitation Outlook



**Comments:** (145% YTD Ave)

Partly cloudy in the morning becoming mostly cloudy. Light east winds up to 10 mph. Temperature highs between 42 and 57 depending on elevation in the basin. Overnight lows between 31 and 46. Persistent morning fog and mostly cloudy conditions are forecast for Wednesday, turning to clear and sunny afternoons by Thursday and through the weekend. Expect temperatures and snowlines to decrease through Sunday then fluctuating up slightly Monday then back down below 5000 ft by Tuesday. Slight chance of precipitation over the high Sierra Thursday and Friday with snowlines about 8000 ft. The only precipitation in the forecast occurs in the hundredths and tenths starting mid-next week when snowlines may be below 6000 ft.

# Northern Sierra Precipitation: 8-Station Index, January 21, 2026










# California Snow Water Content, January 21, 2026, Percent of April 1 Average



Statewide Percent of April 1: 36.0%



Historical Average — Total Reservoir Capacity — 2025-2026(current)


# San Luis Reservoir Storage Levels
