Northern Sierra Precipitation: 8-Station Index, August 24, 2026



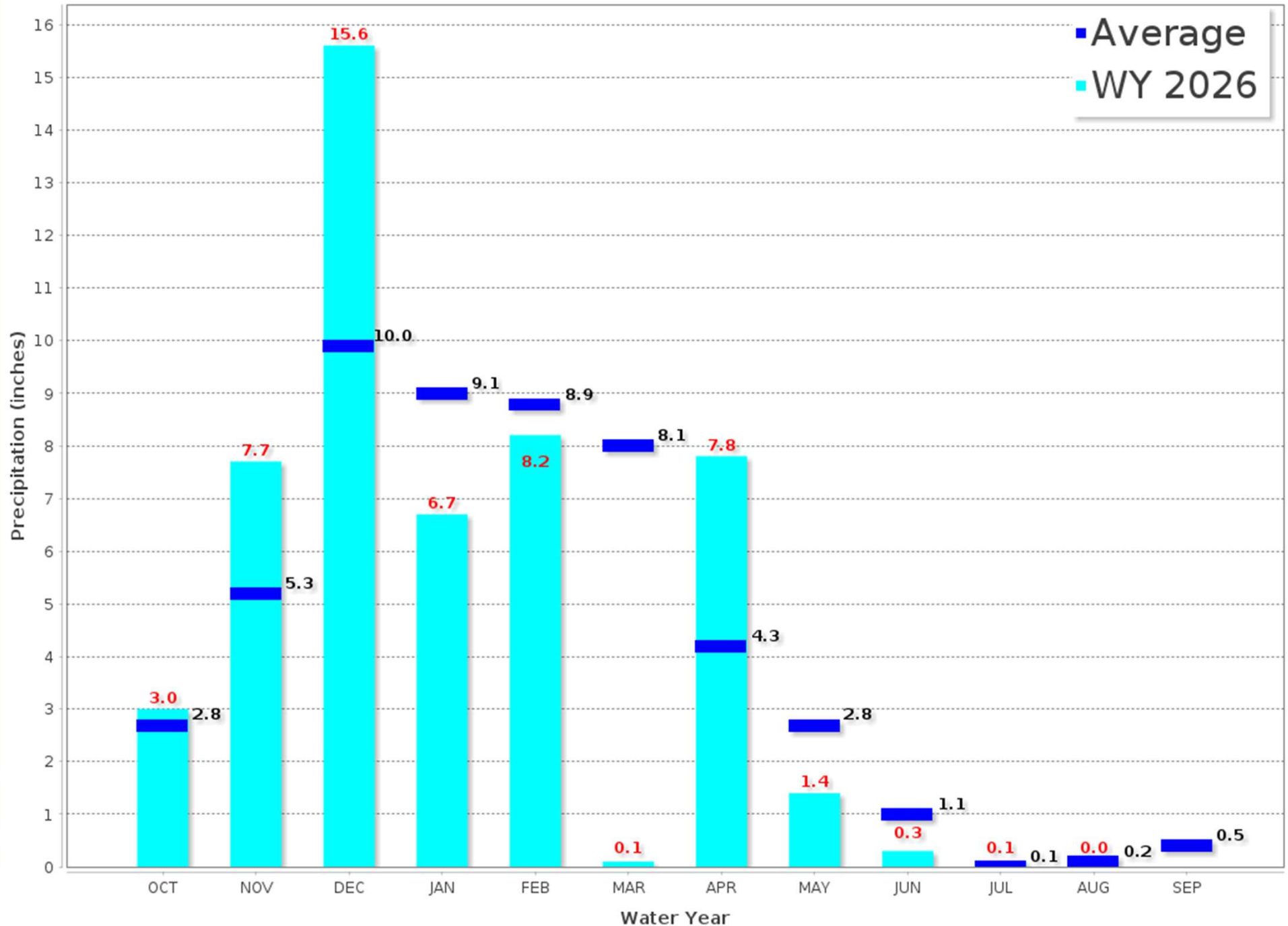

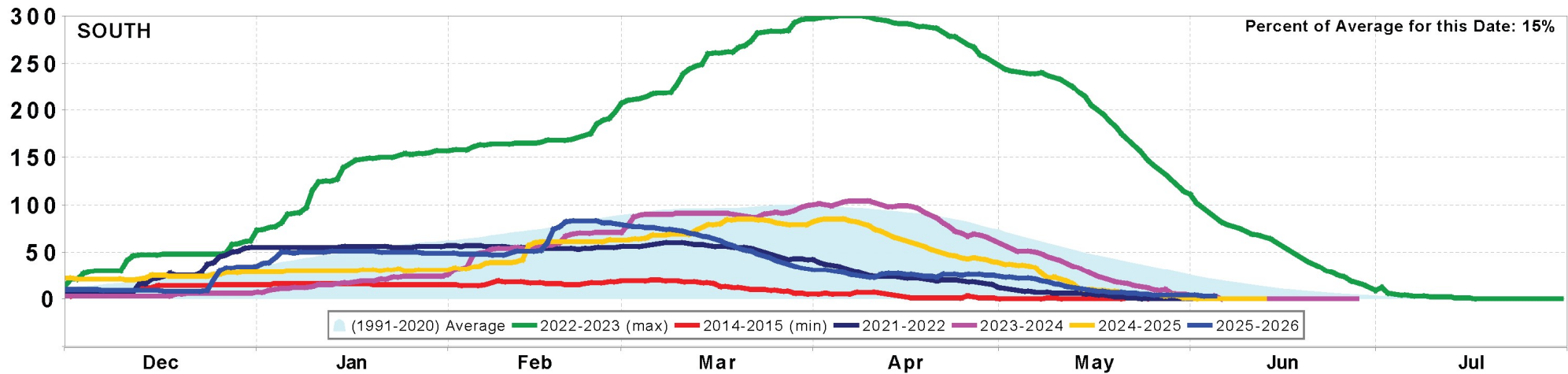

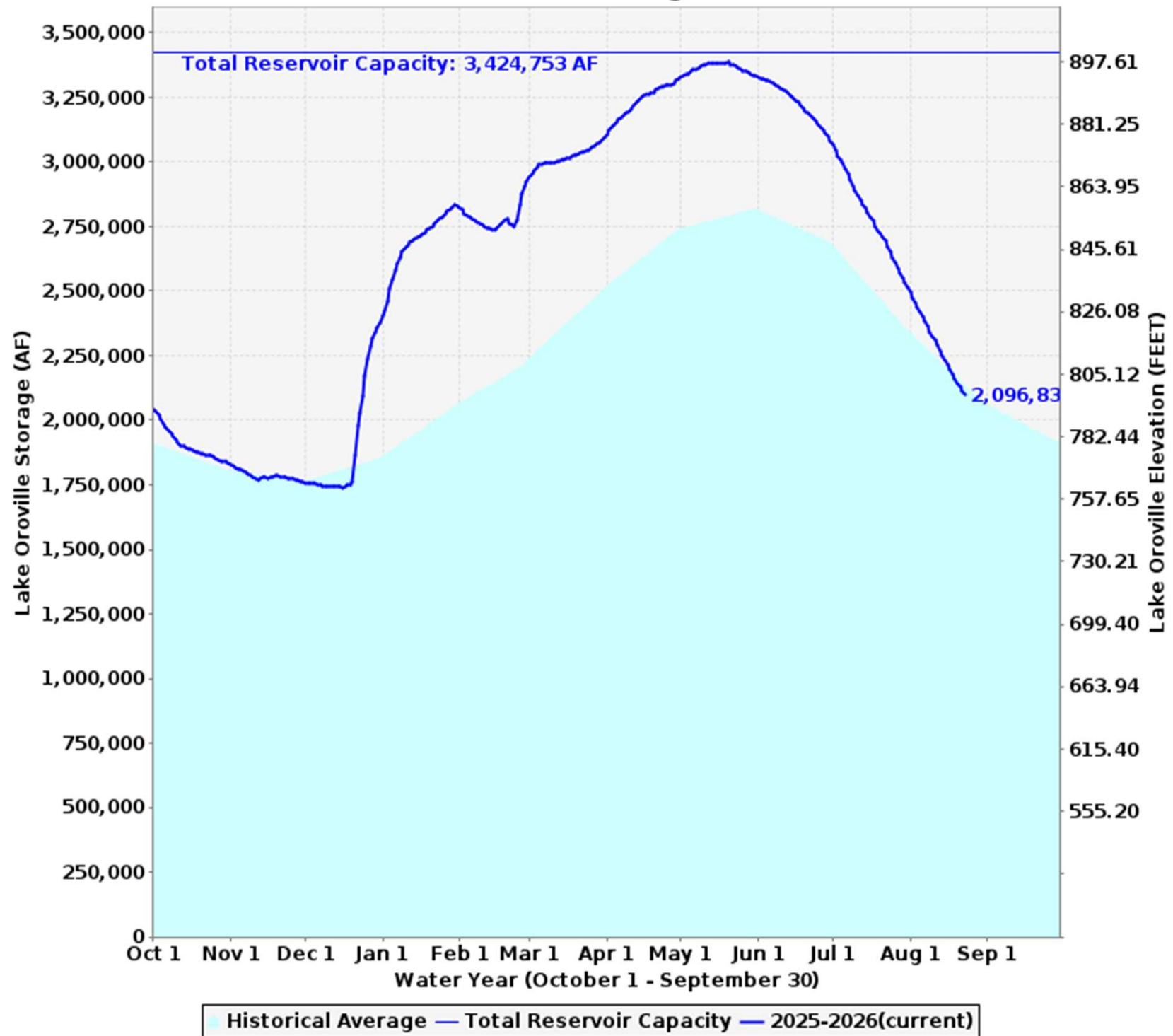
California Snow Water Content, June 5, 2026, Percent of April 1 Average



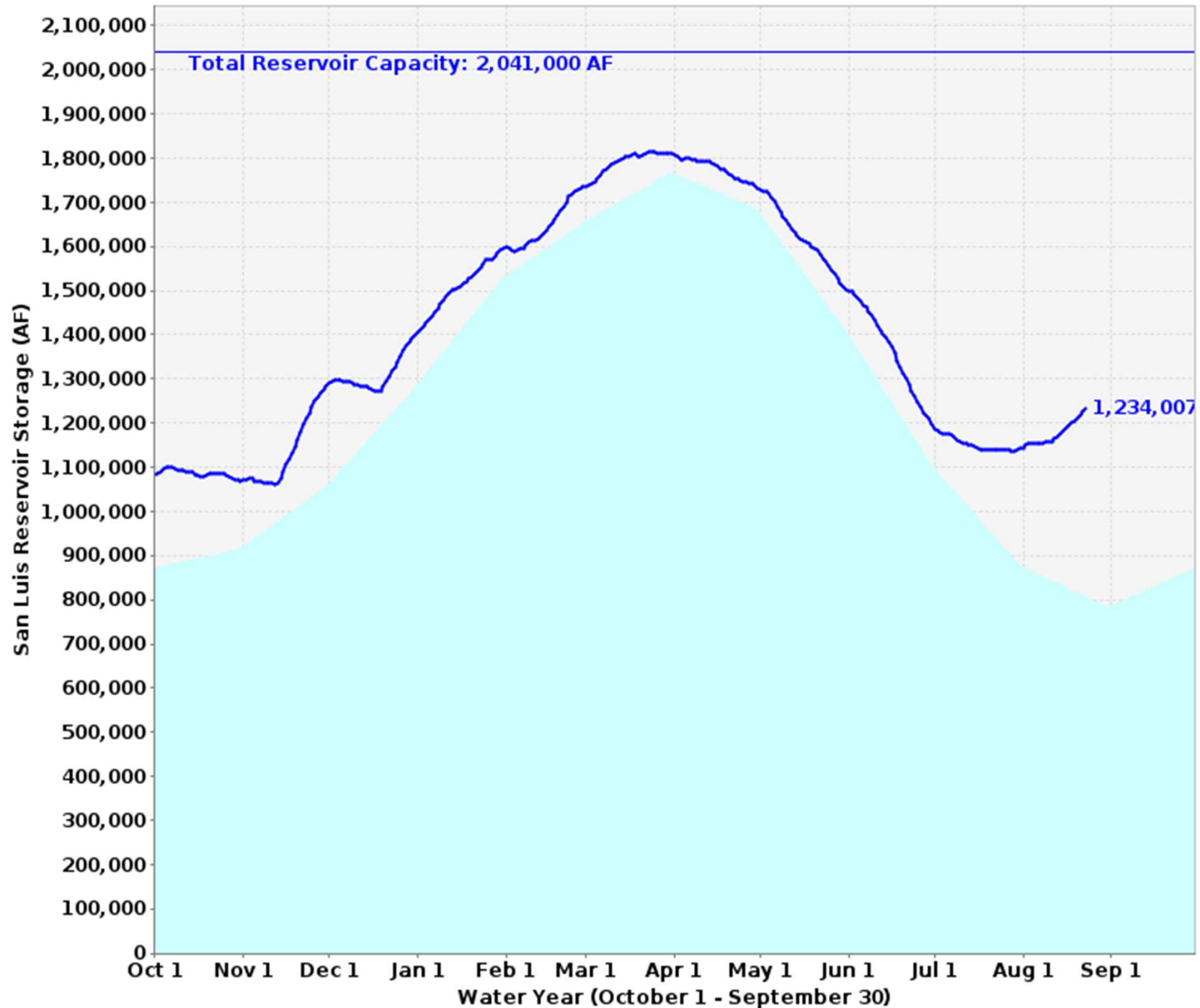

Lake Oroville Storage Levels



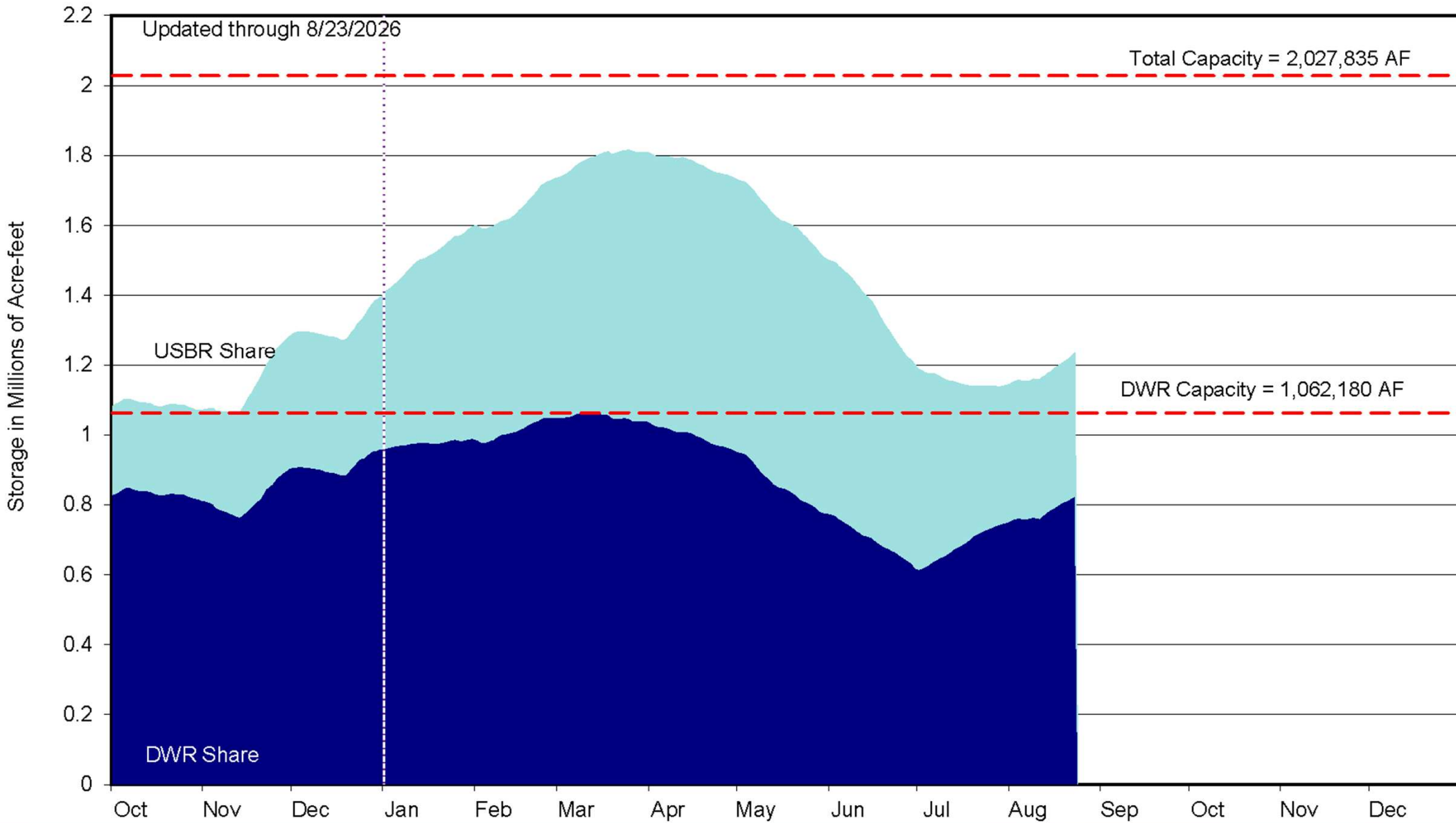
San Luis Reservoir Storage Levels



Historical Average — Total Reservoir Capacity — 2025-2026(current)

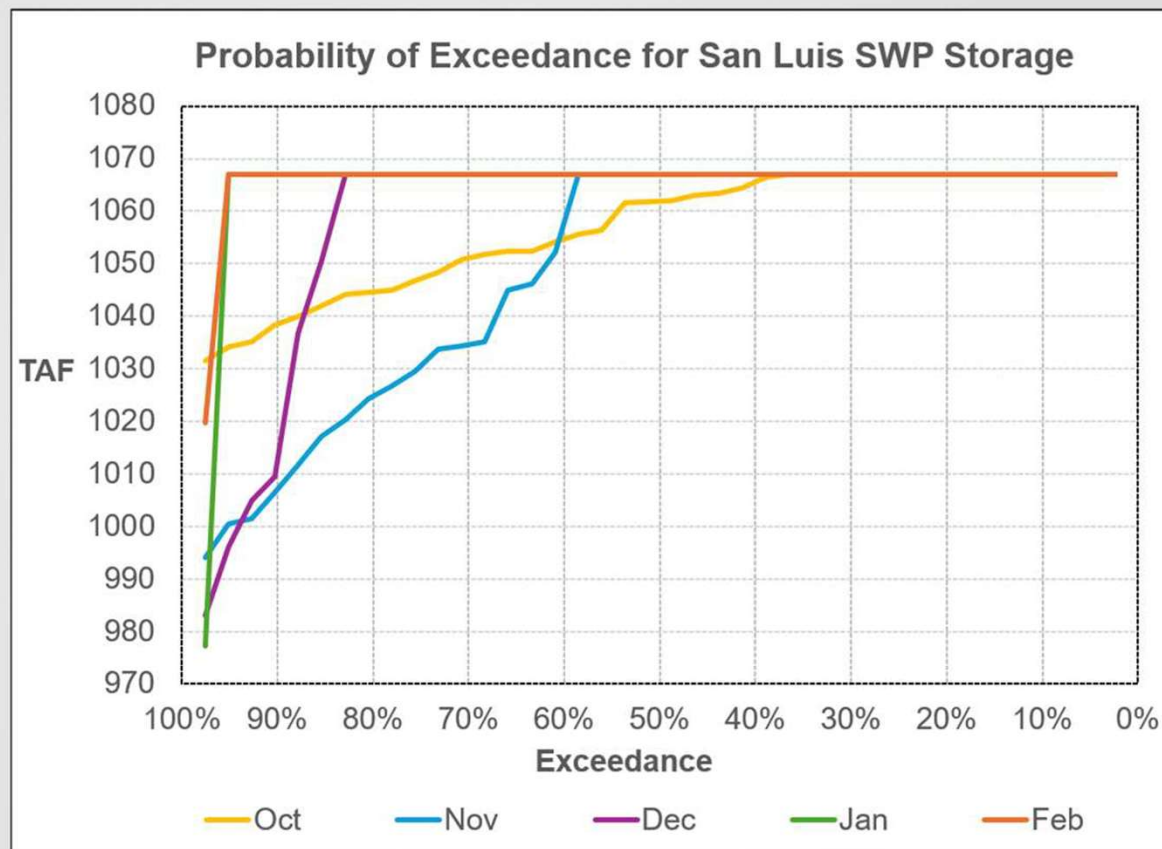

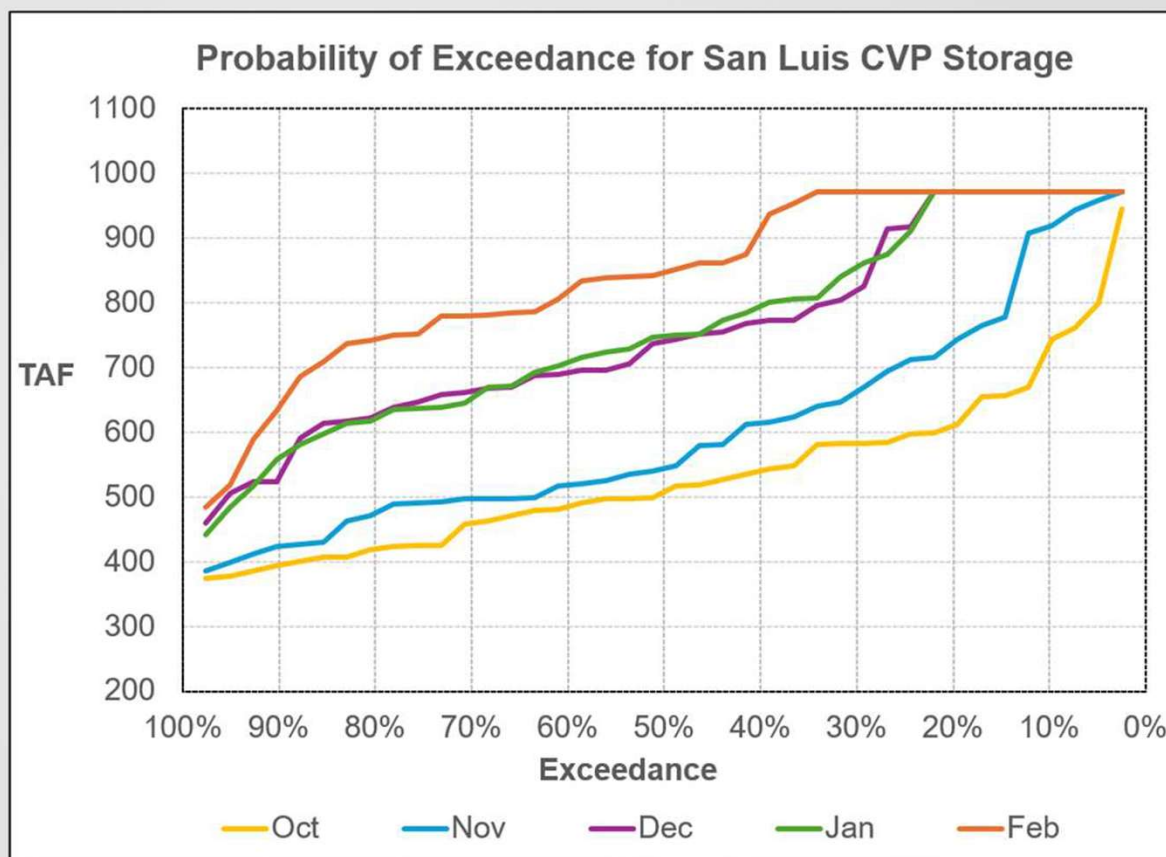

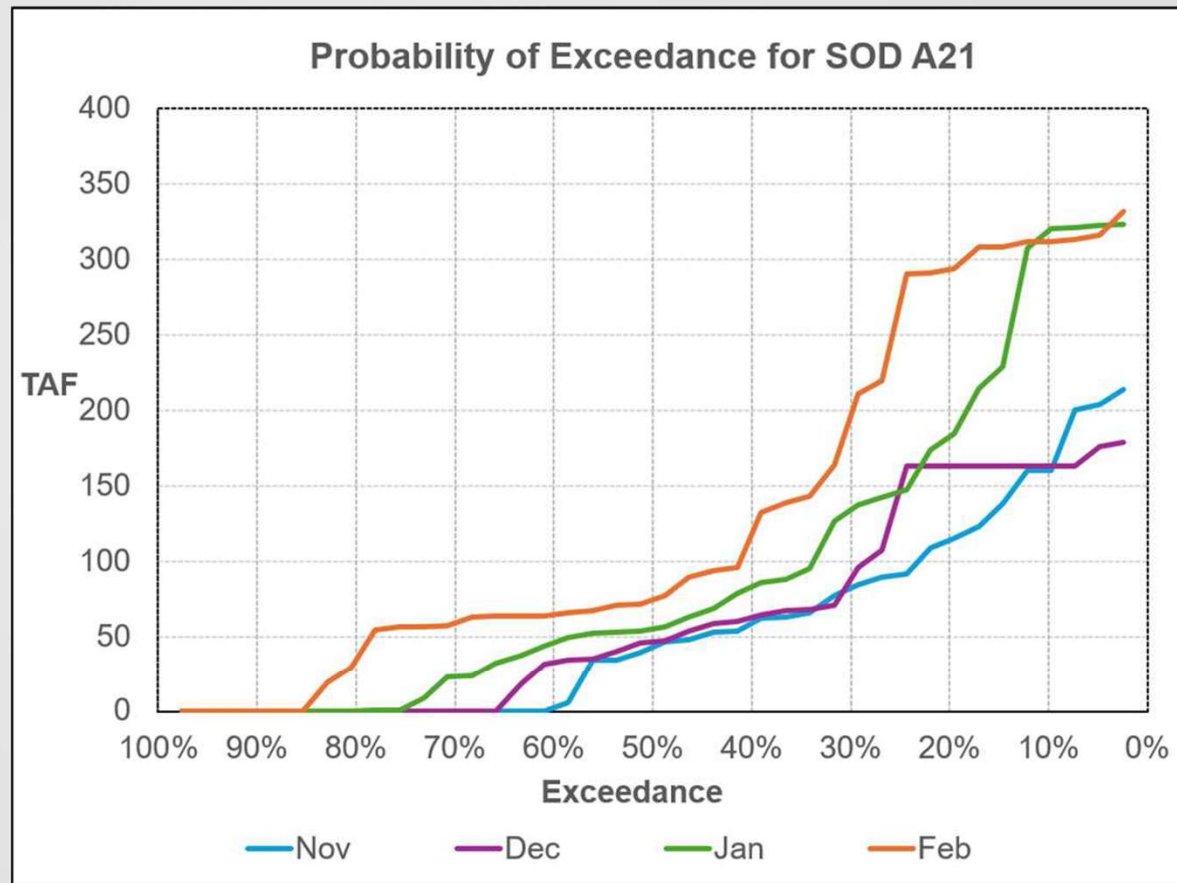
